Foreign exhibitors : Cash payment at the show is possible, also undertakes to pay the fees even if not participating in the show !

Classes:

- **Minor Puppy class** correctly vaccinated up to 6 months of age
- **Puppy class** 6-9 months
- **Junior class** 9-18 months
- **Intermediate class** 15-24 months
- **Open class** 15 months and over
- **Working class** 15 months and over (FCI working certificate compulsory)
- **Champion class** 15 months and over (Championship certificate compulsory)
- **Veteran class** 8 years and over
- **Honorary class** 15 months and over with ICH, CH, Club and Nat Winner titles without CAC
- **Out of competition** in this class is possible to show the dogs without classification and ranking

Titles:

- Best Minor Puppy** Competition for all males and females, qualified Very promising 1 in Minor Puppy class in regular judging. Males and females as well as all breeds compete together .
- Best Puppy** Competition for all males and females qualified Very promising 1 in Puppy class in regular judging. Males and females as well as all breeds compete together.
- Best Veteran** Competition for all veterans (8 years and over), qualified Excellent 1 in Veteran class in regular judging. Males and females as well as all breeds compete together.
- Honour Class Best in Show** Competition for all dogs and bitches qualified excellent 1 in Honour class in regular judging. Males and females as well all breeds compete together.
- CAJC SR** Expectance to Junior Champion of Slovakia may get males and females with valuation of Excellent 1st in junior class. It is not compulsory to award the CAJC SR.
- CAC SR** Expectance to Champion of Slovakia may get males and females with valuation of Exc. 1st in intermediate, open, working or champion class. It is not compulsory to award the CAC SR.
- Reserve CAC SR** may get males and females with valuation of Exc. 2nd in intermediate, open, working or champion class. It is not compulsory to award the Reserve CAC SR.
- Junior Club Winner 2017** may get males and females with valuation of Excellent 1, CAJC.
- Club Winner 2017** may get the best male and best female with valuation of Excellent 1
- BOB (Best of Breed)** The Junior Club Winner, The Club Winner and veterans from both sexes, if awarded Excellent 1, will compete for Best of Breed (BOB).
- BOS (Best of Opposite Sex)** The Junior Club Winner, The Club Winner and veteran with Exc 1, - the best exhibit from the opposite sex.
- BIS (Best in Show)** This title will be awarded to the best dog of all breed winners.

Competitions:

- Best couple** The owner can enter his male and female of the same breed that have been judged in the Club Show. May only be awarded to a couple that possesses the typical features of its breed which are well-balanced and both dogs have the typical features of their sex

Breeder's Group Breeder can enter his breeder's group of at least three dogs and or bitches of the same breed, colour and size which have been judged in that club show. The dogs do not have to be owned by the breeder, but they must come from the same kennel from at least two different litters, at least two different sires and dams. A dog /bitch can only be entered to one breeder's group. Exhibitors are obliged to let their dogs compete in this competition when asked by the breeder.

Child and Dog Open competition for all children up to 9 years and dogs judged at this club show. There will be judged the harmony and cooperation between the child and the dog.

Junior Handling Competition for all junior handlers and dogs. It is for juniors from 9–16 years. The aim of junior handling competitions is to increase the youth's interest in canine activities and promote and develop the co-operation and contacts between dogs and the young people. Harmony and cooperation between the handler and a dog not the quality of a dog, will be judged there.

Best Stud Dog Competition for stud dogs with at least five offsprings that have been judged at this club show. There will be judged a type and quality of their offsprings. A stud dog does not have to be judged in competition.

Best Brood Bitch the brood bitch and at least three offsprings of two sires. There will be judged a type and quality of a brood bitch's offsprings. The brood bitch does not have to be judged in competition.

- The show is held under the FCI and SKJ show regulations.
- Only dogs registered with the stud books recognised by the FCI can enter the show.
- Dogs entered into Minor puppy or Puppy class must have at the time of sending application form valid pedigree, the same is for imported dogs.
- A copy of the pedigree must be enclosed to each application.
- In case of a wrong class on the entry form, the dog will be automatically entered in the correct class according to his age, any dog older than 15 months will in this case be entered in the open class.
- Applications lacking any necessary document (a copy of the International working certificate for the working class, a copy of the Championship certificate for the champion class and a copy of a title awarding for the honorary class) will be automatically entered into the open class without notifying owners.
- The exhibitor commits to pay the exhibition fees even when he/she will not take part at the show.
- Should the show not be held for the unforeseen reasons, the exhibition fees will be used to cover the expenses.
- The organiser may refuse to accept the application without stating the reason.
- The organiser cannot be held responsible for damages caused by/to a dog.
- The owner is responsible for any damages caused by the dog
- By submitting the entry of his/her dog the exhibitor is obliged to abide by the SKJ/FCI show regulations and Slovak veterinary rules. The exhibitor is giving his/ her permission to publish his/her address in the exhibition catalog and on the website of the organizer. He/she also agrees with publishing pictures, results and critiques of his/her dog as much as needed by the organizer, the SKJ or partners of the show.
