#### **CLASSES**

<b>Minor puppy class</b>	correctly inoculated puppies up to 6 months
<b>Puppy class</b>	6 - 9 months
<b>Junior class</b>	9 - 18 months
<b>Intermediate class</b>	15 – 24 months
<b>Working class</b>	15 months and over (FCI working certificate compulsory)
<b>Open class</b>	15 months and over
<b>Champion class</b>	15 months and over (Championship certificate compulsory)
<b>Honorary class</b>	for dogs with titles Interchampion, Champion, National and Club winner (Title certificate compulsory). This class is out of competition and winners are not awarded by CAC. Winners of honour class with "Excellent 1" compete in the finals in own competition.
<b>Veteran class</b>	8 years and over

#### **TITLES**

<b>CAJC SR</b>	Certificate for the Junior Champion title of Slovakia may be awarded to dogs and bitches graded as Excellent 1st in junior class
<b>CAC SR</b>	Certificate for the Champion of Slovakia may be awarded to dogs and bitches graded Excellent 1st in intermediate, open, working or champion class
<b>Reserve CAC SR</b>	may be awarded to dogs and bitches graded as Excellent 2nd in intermediate, open, working or champion class
<b>Junior Club Winner 2022</b>	may get males and females with valuation of Excellent 1, CAJC.
<b>Veteran Club Winner 2022</b>	may be awarded to dogs and bitches graded Excellent 1st in veteran class
<b>Club Winner 2022</b>	may get the best male and best female with valuation of Excellent 1 CAC
<b>Best junior in breed (BOJ)</b>	awarded to best male or female that was honoured with CAJC title
<b>Best of Veterans (BOV)</b>	Competition for the best veteran male and female of the same breed qualified Excellent 1 in Veteran class in regular judging
<b>Best of Breed (BOB)</b>	The Junior Club Winner, The Club Winner and The Veteran Club Winner from both sexes, if awarded Excellent 1, will compete for Best of Breed.

<b>Best of Opposite Sex (BOS)</b>	The Junior Club Winner, The Club Winner and The Veteran Club Winner, the best exhibit from the opposite sex
<b>Best Minor Puppy</b>	Competition for all males and females, qualified Very promising 1 in Minor Puppy class in regular judging. Males and females as well as all breeds compete together
<b>Best Puppy</b>	Competition for all males and females qualified Very promising 1 in Puppy class in regular judging. Males and females as well as all breeds compete together
<b>BIS Veteran</b>	may be awarded to a male or female awarded with BOV title, all breeds together
<b>BIS Honour Class</b>	may be awarded to a male or female awarded with Excellent 1 from honour class of all breeds.
<b>Best in Show (BIS)</b>	for all males and females awarded with BOB

## COMPETITIONS

<b>Best Brace</b>	The owner can enter his male and female of the same breed that have been judged in the Club Show. May only be awarded to a couple that possesses the typical features of its breed which are well-balanced and both dogs have the typical features of their sex
<b>The best Breeder's group:</b>	Breeder can enter his breeder's group of at least three dogs and or bitches of the same breed, colour and size which have been judged in that club show. The dogs do not have to be owned by the breeder, but they must come from the same kennel from at least two different litters, at least two different sires and dams. A dog /bitch can only be entered to one breeder's group. Exhibitors are obliged to let their dogs compete in this competition when asked by the breeder.
<b>Child and Dog</b>	Open competition for all children up to 9 years and dogs judged at this club show. There will be judged the harmony and cooperation between the child and the dog.
<b>Junior Handling</b>	Competition for all junior handlers and dogs is divided into two categories: the 1st category: 9-13 years, the 2nd category: 14-17 years. The main aim of junior handling competitions is to increase the youth's interest in canine activities and promote and develop the co-operation and contacts between dogs and the young people. The quality of a dog will not be judged there, but the handling.
<b>Best Stud</b>	Competition for stud dogs with at least five offsprings that have been judged at this club show. There will be judged a type and quality of their offsprings. A stud dog does not have to be judged in competition.
<b>Best Brood Bitch</b>	the brood bitch and at least three offsprings of two sires. There will be judged a type and quality of a brood bitch's offsprings. The brood bitch does not have to be judged in competition

## GENERAL TERMS

- The show is held under the FCI and SKJ show regulations.
- Only dogs registered with the stud books recognised by the FCI can enter the show.
- Dogs entered into Minor puppy or Puppy class must have at the time of sending application form valid pedigree, the same is for imported dogs.
- A copy of the pedigree must be enclosed to each application.
- In case of a wrong class on the entry form, the dog will be automatically entered in the correct class according to his age, any dog older than 15 months will in this case be entered in the open class.
- Applications lacking any necessary document (a copy of the International working certificate for the working class, a copy of the Championship certificate for the champion class and a copy of a title awarding for the honorary class) will be automatically entered into the open class without notifying owners.
- The exhibitor commits to pay the exhibition fees even when he/she will not take part at the show.
- Should the show not be held for the unforeseen reasons, the exhibition fees will be used to cover the expenses.
- The organiser may refuse to accept the application without stating the reason.
- The organiser cannot be held responsible for damages caused by/to a dog.
- The owner is responsible for any damages caused by the dog.
- The exhibitor is responsible for the well-being of his dog at the show – he must not expose him to situations that could endanger his health or even his life, e.g., leave it in the car in extreme winter or heat or treat it cruelly. Anyone who violates these principles can be excluded from this show.
- The exhibitor by entering the dog for the show as a person concerned in accordance with § 13 of Act no. 18/2018 Coll. on the protection of personal data, gives its consent to the organizer for the processing of his personal data (name, surname) and agrees to their publication (name, surname), photo documentation and results of the show on the organizer's website.

## PROTEST

*The protest can be submitted only for formal reasons, in a writing form at the exhibition office, during the exhibition, until the end of the assessment in rings at the same time with the deposit of 50 €, which will be forfeited if the exhibitor is against. Protest against the judge's decision of the judge (referee), against the award, the awarded title, etc. is not allowed.*
